PROGRAM NOTES

T is a rare and beautiful occurrence when an artist manages to interweave his personal life, spiritual path, and art. After releasing five CDs of varying styles from the late 90s through 2008, SAUL KAYE was pulled towards an idea that he claimed wouldn't leave him alone. This was the natural marriage of Jewish history, characters, and liturgy with the Blues. This lead to the release of Jewish Blues Volume One–Live! This CD was so successful, that Saul went on to release Jewish



Blues Volumes two and three, a Kabbalat Shabbat CD and plays over 120 shows/services/festivals per year in over 30 states and on four continents.



KLEZMER JUICE is the new generation of Jewish Soul music. With wide-ranging international backgrounds, a youthful vibe, and an exciting Latin undertone to their music, they are the torchbearers of an ancient traditional craft that unites generations in spirit. They create fresh interpretations of traditional and original tunes that capture the hearts of a new generation of fans.

THE CBB SHIR CHADASH YOUTH and ADULT CHOIRS plus the YOUTH CHOIR OF TEMPLE BETH EL OF SAN PEDRO with Cantors MARK CHILDS and ILAN DAVIDSON. The Adult Choir can be heard throughout the year at the first Friday night service of each month. The Shir Chadash Youth Choir is composed of CBB students in second through sixth grades. CBB is a very musical congregation and encourages everyone to sing along and to let the spirit of Jewish music lift their souls and accompany them through simcha and sorrow alike. CBB's music program is sponsored this year by DANIEL & MANDY HOCHMAN.

MICHAL, OSNAT, and PHILLIP have taught and led Israeli folk dancing in Santa Barbara for over 10 years, classic and modern dances for all ages and all levels. Come learn Israeli dancing or come to dance the dances you know and love (we are open to requests!).
