Rabbi Charles Sherman is a very gifted congregational rabbi with a distinguished career serving the Jewish people in many leadership capacities. Shortly after the surgery, his four year old had a brain-stem stroke leaving him a quadriplegic and voiceless, requiring a ventilator to breathe. *The Broken and the Whole*, is the Sherman family's remarkable story of embracing life through the challenges and blessings associated with Eyal's journey.
