A MESSAGE FROM ADAM

Inclusion is the word of the month. February is Jewish Disability Awareness and Inclusion Month (JDAIM) and as a community, we are giving serious thought to the question of how we can be more welcoming and inclusive to people with disabilities.

Unfortunately, when we speak of inclusion, often we are really talking about "not excluding." That is, many times we make accommodation to ensure the presence of people with disabilities at an outing or event, but we don't take the extra step of ensuring that those with physical or developmental disabilities, or those with mental health challenges can be fully immersed in the exercise, whether it be social, functional, or educational. We often even go so far as to segregate within an inclusive environment, meaning that while those who are different are in the room, they are not interwoven into the group.

Calgary Jewish Federation has promoted awareness of inclusion of people with disabilities over the last several years, and as a community, we can commend ourselves for making strides in improving participatory access to events, venues, and initiatives. Still, we have a long way to go. This month, for Jewish Disability Awareness and Inclusion Month, many of our Jewish communal organizations and synagogues, will be offering special programming focused

on creating awareness of inclusion and its challenges and opportunities, as well as programming specifically inclusive activities. Please look for our featured community ad in this edition of JFP, and mark on your calendar several event dates in which to participate. Don't miss our event with Alvin Law on February 7. Alvin is an amazing motivational speaker who demonstrates that being born without arms is no obstacle to fully engaging in life.

This month we are also mindful of another aspect of inclusion – and that is the inclusion of those facing financial challenges, loss of jobs, loss of pride, and loss of ability to support family. In these difficult economic times, many people in Jewish Calgary have lost jobs, had their job loads or salaries reduced, or wake up every day wondering how secure their jobs are. This, in addition to the scores of people who were without work even before the economy turned.

While this is likely to be a slow trudge through difficult times, we are incredibly proud of our community, our donors, and our organizations and schools for doing their very best to make sure Jewish Calgary remains strong, and that those who need scholarships, who benefit from counselling, who need to find a safe place to socialize, exercise, and gather can have access to those things.

Our community is weathering the storm as best it can,

but we need to do more. I would like to appeal to anyone or any organization
